- Graduated from the JKA Kenshusei in 1973. As the captain of the Tokyo's Hosei University he distinguished himself in many of the university championships around Kanto area and throughout Japan. As an instructor at the JKA he had developed his own training and teaching methodologies.
- Since the establishment of the WSKF, he has invested much of his time in refining and expanding his unique concepts. What characterizes Kasuya sensei's ideas and concepts the most is the openness with which he approaches them. He is constantly trying to re-evaluate his views and find the best ways to express them. His character and amiable personality have made him popular with the younger generations, as much as his professionalism and demure have made him well respected by the more senior ones. He has been considered by many senior teachers in and outside Japan as one of the most innovative karate instructors in the world.

- 1975 I.A.K.F part of the champion Team for Kumite and Kata in Los Angeles, USA
- 1976 Won 1st place at the Asian Pacific Championships in Hong Kong.
- 1977 I.A.K.F. part of the champion Team for Kumite and Kata in Tokyo, Japan.
- 1980 selected member of the Japanese National Team to compete at the 5th W.U.K.O. championships in Spain.
- Kasuya Sensei leaves the JKA and helps establish the SKIF with Kanazawa Sensei.
- 1982 Part of the Japan National Team that competed in the 6th W.U.K.O. championships in Taipei, Taiwan.
- 1983 S.K.I.F. 1st World Championships in Tokyo, Japan, he wins individual Kata and he is part of the champion Kumite Team.
- 1985 S.K.I.F 2nd World Championships in Germany, he wins individual Kumite.
- 1990 The World Shotokan Karate-Do Federation is established.
